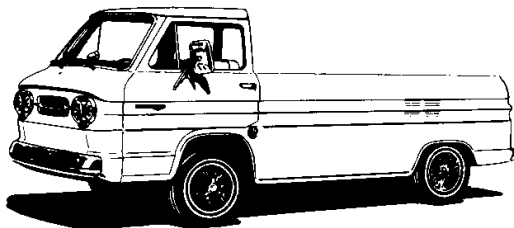
CORSA divides the country into Eastern, Central and Western divisions with elected directors representing their regions.

CORSA is international in scope with current members in Canada, Iceland, the Netherlands, France, Australia and Sweden.

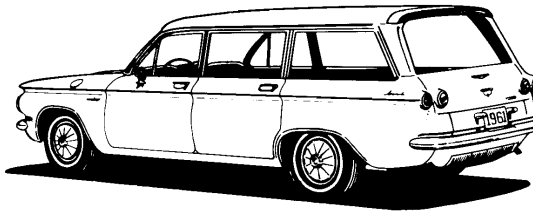

Club e-mails are sent out periodically to remind, announce, and explain club happenings.

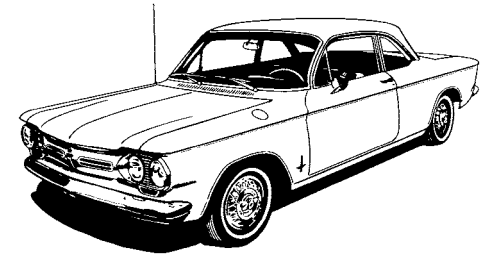

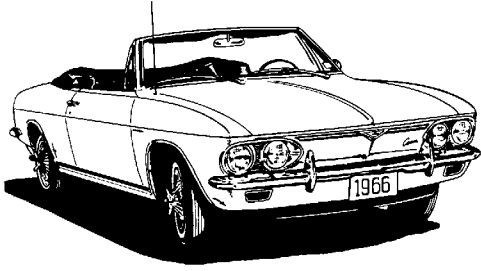
Welcome to *Heart of America Corvair Owners Association*

Heart of America Corvair Owners Association History

Heart of America Corvair Owner Association was formed by four Corvair enthusiasts in the spring of 1964. The club was incorporated in April of that year and has been in continuous existence since that time, thus allowing the club to claim the title of the oldest, incorporated, single marque, continually active Corvair Club in the country.

The original goal of the club was to promote the car as a competition sports machine. For this reason, the early club events centered on rallies and gymkhana events. The club soon broadened its goal to include family oriented and social events.

In the greater Kansas City area HACO A has enjoyed very active membership through out the years. Because of its members the club has hosted many CORSA sanctioned events including the 1982 Vair Trek, our Twentieth Anniversary Celebration in 1984, the CORSA National Convention in 1989, our 40th Anniversary Celebration in 2004, and the Great Plains Round UP in 2007.

HACO A events

Meetings are held the second Tuesday evening of every month currently at Paul and Jack's Tavern, 1808 Clay Street North Kansas City, MO . Social time from 7:00 to 7:30 with the meeting beginning at 7:30.

After each meeting a program is presented. Topics range from mountain climbing to beer making to improving Corvair performance.

Twice a year our venue changes; in June we take our meeting out of doors to Sar Ko Par Park in Lenexa, KS. Our December meeting is our Holiday Party combining Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's celebrations. Holiday party venue change from year to year.

Each month there is usually at least one other social event; either a gathering at a members home, a parade, a car display, a night at the races, or attending a performance of a local play. Corvair Tech Session are presented from time to time as are Working Tech Sessions, where members help other members fix each others cars.

We hold our annual auction at the April meeting. Donated items are auctioned off during the meeting and the proceeds are given to charity.

In late September, or early October every year we participate in the Great Plains Round Up. This is a rotating regional convention hosted by one of four clubs from the cities of Oklahoma City, Wichita, Tulsa and Kansas City. The events are also attended by members of Texas, Colorado, Iowa, and Nebraska clubs.
